

<u>Year R Homework Letter - Friday 2nd December</u>

Phonics

This week we have been revising all the phonemes and Harder to Read and Spell words we have learnt so far this term.

Literacy: Little Red Riding Hood

This week we have focused once again on fairytales before we start the run-up to Christmas. In our Literacy lessons we read the story of 'Little Red Riding Hood' together. Most of the children were already familiar with this traditional tale and could tell us events which happened in the story and key characters before even reading the story. We thought about question words and tried to name a few (what, why, how, why, who). We then trried to use these words to formulate our own questions about the story. In our Enhanced Provision, the children enjoyed writing 'Get Well Soon Cards' to Granny and creating mazes with 'mega bloks' to reenact Little Red Riding Hood finding her way to Granny's house in the wood whilst avoiding the wolf. Some of the children wrote excellent 'wanted' posters for the Big, Bad Wolf!

Maths

In our Maths lessons this week we have been learning how to find one more and one less of a number. We have done this through singing counting songs such as 'Five Little Speckled Frogs' and 'Five Little Monkies bouncing on the bed. 'We also used duplo bricks to build towers which increase and decrease in size by one. In our Enhanced provision the children found five teddies, each with a different numbered birthday badge. Each teddy had a dough cake and the children had to put on the correct amount of candles which corresponded to their birthday badge.

Reading Buddies

On Thursday 8th December children will spend some time reading with their Year 6 buddies. Please could children bring in a favourite book or a Christmas book on this day.

Homework

Please continue to read daily with your child and write a comment in your child's yellow reading log. We will read with your child once a week, but provide you with two books. We have also set an E-Book on Oxford Owl for you to read with your child.
