<u>English</u>

This week in our English lessons we have read, sequenced and discussed in our own words our story in English 'Bear Under the Stairs' story. We use a story planner to pinpoint 6 important parts of the story and then used these to retell it. We had some super writing! Lots of interesting sentence starters, good punctuation (apostrophes and speech) and lovely handwriting! Now we are moving on to writing our own version. We have taken the barebones of the story and adapted it by changing the main character, the creature and the place where the mysterious creature is found! We are focusing on checking our use of capital letters and full stops, and adding sentence starters and adverbs.

<u>Loveworks</u>

Following the excellent response over the last few years, we have once again decided to support the local charity Loveworks as one of our half termly 'love projects.' Loveworks helps those in need of food and can also offer support with paying utility bills. To support Loveworks, we are running our 'A Tin A Week' project again. 
