Thank you parents for all the super costumes.

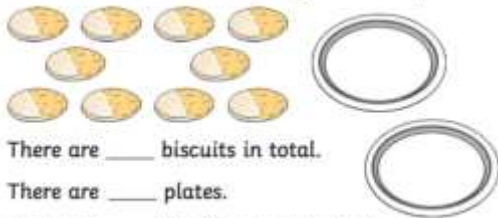
English
