This week Year 3 participated in their termly Wellbeing Wednesday morning P.E Lesson. Pete, their coach for the day, was extremely pleased with their behaviour, level or determination and progress since their last session.

English:

Year 3 have continued to look at our book 'The Pied Piper of Hamlin' by Michael Morpurgo and Emma Chichester Clark. This week the class have been writing to persuade the Mayor of Hamlin that the rat infestation is a serious issue. To do this, we have been learning to write factually, using a variety of conjunctions to extend our sentences and give our view points. At the end of the week then class used what they had learned to write a formal letter to convince the Mayor that action must be taken.

Maths:

This week in class we have moved onto division and have focused on a new method for calculating answers. Within the children's homework books you will find a modelled example of how to do this division method. Please use this to support their learning and understanding.

Loveworks:

We are supporting Loveworks as one of our half termly 'love projects.' Love Works helps those in need of food and can also offer support with paying utility bills. To support LoveWorks, we are running our 'A Tin A Week' project again. As the name suggests, we are asking for children to bring in one item a week for the next five weeks.
