



<u>Year 4 Homework Letter - Friday 20th January 2023</u>

Our Learning This Week English

In English this week, the children have continued exploring our current text, 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe' by C.S. Lewis. The children have written stanzas about the Turkish Delight sweet which features in the story using abstract nouns to enhance the poetic nature of their work. They have also spent time taking on the role of investigative journalists to find out more information about a key invent in the story. The children learnt how to infer a character's feelings through finding evidence in the text. They then created an 'emotions graph' for the first five chapters in relation to Edmund to show the range of emotions experienced by the character. The children are really enjoying this text and are applying themselves fully to all aspects of our learning.

<u>Maths</u>

This week the children have been learning to divide 2-digit and 3 -digit numbers by a 1-digit number. Initially, the children carried out divisions where the tens and ones are both divisible by the number being divided by without any remainders, for example $96 \div 3$ and $84 \div 4$. They then moved on to calculations where they need to exchange between tens and ones, for example $96 \div 4$. Place value counters were used to explore the sharing structure of division. The children use informal jottings or representations such as a part-whole model to record their working.
