

<u> Year R Homework Letter – Fríday 13th January</u>


Phonícs

This week we have learnt the phonemes: ar, ur, oo (long vowel sound as in 'food') or. We have also learnt the following Harder to Read and Spell Words: they, all, are.

Our Learning this week

In our literacy lessons this week we have been reading the book 'Mr Gumpy's Motor Car' by John Burningham. In this story Mr Gumpy's car gets stuck in the mud and he needs to be rescued. As a class we discussed some of the car journeys the children had been on. We talked about the length of the journey and how they passed the time. In the story a number of animals help Mr Gumpy get his car working again. As a class, we used our phonological knowledge to write a list of all the animals who helped push Mr Gumpy's car out of the mud. In our literacy focus group, we continued with the theme of lists and each child wrote a list of items that they would need to pack if they were going on holiday.

In our Maths lessons this week we have learning about the composition of the numbers 4 and 5. We used coloured jewels and two treasure chests to investigate the different ways we could share the 4 and 5 jewels between the two chests. Later on in the week we looked at part-whole models. The part whole model is a pictorial representation that shows the relationship between a whole and its parts.
