## English:

This week Year 3 started a new book called 'The Tear Thief' by Carol Ann Duffy. We began creating questions about the book using the limited information available from the pictures. As a class we also looked at the authors use of verbs, looking at how they added detail to the text as well as informed us of the tense it is written in. later on in the week the children focused again on Carol Ann Duffy's use of metaphors and similes to again add another layer of flair to the story.

### <u>Maths:</u>

In maths this week we have been looking at converting between measurements.

These are:

10mm in 1cm	100cm in 1metre
20mm in 2cm	200cm in 2metres
100mm in 10cm	1000cm in 10 metres
150mm in 15cm	1000mm in 1 metre

Later on in the week, we then looked at adding and subtracting lengths of different types.

*Example:* 4metres 24cm + 345cm = 789cm
