- Please learn the spellings in homework books. We discussed these suffixes in class this week - when the vowel sound is short as in pat and hum, the consonant is doubled.
- Keep practising your 2, 5 and 10 times tables using songs and reciting them daily to commit to memory. It is really helpful when counting money.
- Please complete the 'make the total' worksheet. There is also a game set on Purple Mash, the children can complete either one or both.
- Remember to read every school day and write in the reading record (date, name of book and an initial will suffice thank you).
