### English

This week was assessment week so we have been practicing our reading, spelling and grammar.

This week we began reading 'Wolves'. This is a fictional story with a non-fiction twist. We talked about the portrayal of wolves in popular stories and then talked about adjectives which describe a wolf. We have learnt lots of interesting facts about them which we will use to write a non-chronological report next week.

### Maths

This week we had an arithmetic assessment. Please continue to practise these skills at home - practise makes perfect!

Fractions is a very tricky concept which children find difficult so please keep finding opportunities to talk about them if you can at home.

This week we started learning about money - the different coins and how our times tables skills can help when counting money.

- Please learn the spellings in homework books. We discussed these suffixes in class this week - when the vowel sound is short as in pat and hum, the consonant is doubled.
- Keep practising your 2, 5 and 10 times tables using songs and reciting them daily to commit to memory. It is really helpful when counting money.
- Please complete the 'make the total' worksheet. There is also a game set on Purple Mash, the children can complete either one or both.
- Remember to read every school day and write in the reading record (date, name of book and an initial will suffice - thank you).
