Welcome back Year 3! I do hope you all had a restful Easter and that you are all looking forward to the Summer term!



English:

This week Year 3 have begun to look at our new book 'Flotsam' by David Wiesner. Flotsam is a textless book that allows the children to be creative and imagine what is happening and what might happen next. This week we started by telling the story to each other using our own thoughts and ideas with a focus on fronted adverbials to accurately sequence the story.

Maths:

This week we have recapped on fractions and have been ordering and comparing them. Towards the end of the week we moved onto adding and subtracting fractions that have the same denominator. We finished the week off by learning how to find an amount from a whole number.

$$\frac{1}{5} + \frac{3}{5} = \frac{1+3}{5} = \frac{4}{5}$$

$\frac{3}{4}$ of 36

Divide by the denominator then multiply by the numerator

$$36 \div 4 = 9 \times 3 = 27$$

($\frac{3}{4}$ of 36 = 27)
