#### **Advent Celebrations**

Sunday 4th December 2022 marked the second Sunday of Advent. We have been learning about Advent in our Collective Worships. Next week, we will light the third and fourth candles as we count down the weeks to Christmas! Traditionally, the Advent wreath symbolises the passage of the four weeks of Advent. It is typically a circular candle holder that holds five candles. During the season of Advent one candle on the wreath is lit each Sunday. At school we light one each week until all of the candles are lit. Each candle customarily represents an aspect of the spiritual preparation for the celebration of the birth of our Lord, Jesus Christ. The Advent wreath we use in school has three colours of candles – purple, pink, and white.

1st CANDLE – (purple) THE PROPHECY CANDLE or CANDLE OF HOPE 2nd CANDLE – (purple) THE BETHLEHEM CANDLE or THE CANDLE OF PREPARATION 3rd CANDLE – (pink) THE SHEPHERD CANDLE or THE CANDLE OF JOY 4th CANDLE – (purple) THE ANGEL CANDLE or THE CANDLE OF LOVE 5th CANDLE – (white) CHRIST CANDLE
