The children discovered a letter that was about being yourself. They made statements about their dreams and wishes before we shared the text.

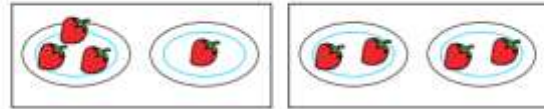
### Homework
