Year 3 continued to look at the book 'Flotsam' by David Wiesner. This week the children have been learning to write persuasively with the aim of convincing the reader to protect the worlds oceans. This week we have written persuasive letters and designs, influential environment posters, sales adverts and imaginary television skits.

Maths:

This week we continued to focus on time. As a class we covered: telling the time in intervals of five and one minute intervals, using AM and PM; telling the time on an analogue clock; telling the time on a digital clock; duration of events and timing how long events last.
