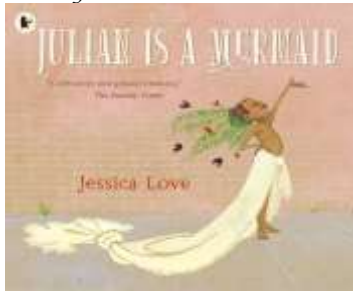




## Year 1 Homework Letter - Friday 9<sup>th</sup> June 2023
