




## Year 1 Homework Letter - Friday 16<sup>th</sup> June 2023

### English

This week we have started a new unit using the book 'Iggy Peck, Architect' by Andrea Betty. When a new second grade teacher declares her dislike of architecture, Iggy faces a challenge. He loves building too much to give it up!



The children enjoyed being architects and having the challenge of building the tallest or strongest or most creative structure. They then wrote statements as labels for their models, predicted what might happen next in the story and made inferences on the basis of what is being said and done.
