Our Learning This Week English

In English, the children have started our new text for this half term, 'Westlandia' by Paul Fleischman. It begins with children creating a shelter for their own civilization, as a hook to create engagement with the text. The first part then continues with children making predictions, describing Wesley's character and eventually retelling the story in their own words. In the second part, the children begin by creating a non-chronological report, published as a brochure for Weslandia itself, using planning models and information from and inferred from the text.

Maths - Multiplication Tables Check

This week the children have been practicing using the Department for Education 'Try it Out' check so that they were able to experience what the check will actually be like. We will be doing the check during the mornings of Tuesday 13th, Wednesday 14th and Thursday 15th June. The children will be taken down to the Southwark Room in small groups of six on one of the mornings to complete the check on the i-pads, which will take no longer than 15 minutes. The children have all being working really hard on their times tables of many months, thank you for all your support of this at home and please encourage your child to continue practicing so they are feeling prepared and confident for the check.

Homework

The English activities are to learn Week 1 spellings. For Maths the children must practise all of their times tables and complete the worksheet on angles.
