Our Learning This Week

English

In English, the children continued exploring our new text, 'Westlandia' by Paul Fleischman. This week, we spent time designing our own alternative civilisations just as the main character, Wesley, had done in the story. The children did this in two stages, first of all they laid down their design ideas using the program 2Animate on Purple Mash on the i-Pads. Once this was completed the second phase was to draw out and colour their designs on A4 card which are now being displayed in our classroom.

Maths - Multiplication Tables Check

This week the children have all completed their MTC. I am very proud of them for all of their hard work in preparation for this check and for the mature way in which they conducted themselves whilst doing the check using the i-Pads in the Southwark Room in groups of three. The results of the MTC will be attached on your child's school report which will be sent out on Friday 30th June.

Maths

In Maths the children have continued to learn about Shape. The children explored different types of triangles by looking at examples and non-examples of triangles to help them summarise the characteristics of a triangle: a closed, 2-D shape with three straight sides. We then considered the properties of different types of triangles, for example, if all three sides have different lengths, the triangle is scalene.

The children have been working hard this week to learn and rehearse our maypole dances for the Summer Garden Party on Saturday 24th June. We have learnt two dances and will be learning our third dance during the course of next week. The children have done so well with their dancing and are making such a great effort to learn the routines ready to perform for you at the Garden Party!
