



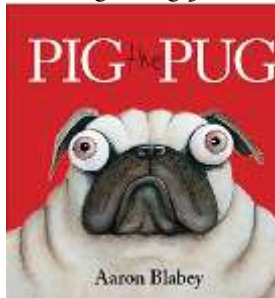
Year 1 Homework Letter - Friday 14th July 2023
