




# <u>Year 1 Homework Letter - Friday 30th June 2023</u>

## <u>English</u>

This week we started a new unit on money. We identified the value of different counters and began to transfer that understanding to coins. We then continued to explore and recognise the value of different denominations of coins. Finally we discussed equivalence, that a 20p coin is equivalent to twenty 1p coins and also two 10p coins.

#### Homework

Hide a selection of 1p, 2p, 5p and 1op coins and pre-money counters up to the value of 10 around your home. Ask your child to find matching pairs. Give your child a range of different coins to explore. Are they able to recognise and name each coin? Can they sort the coins? Which are pounds and which are pence? How do they know?
