<u>Year 2 Homework Letter - Fríday 7th July 2023</u>


It has been such a busy week! Thank you to the parents who came to see our wonderful Art Exhibition and those I had an opportunity to talk to at the Open Evening. On Thursday, Year 2 had their 'Move Up' afternoon with their new teacher – Mrs Cordey!!

<u>Englísh</u>

Firstly, we planned and wrote a recount of our trip to Tower Bridge, focusing on ensuring it was written in chronological order and the use of time adverbials – first, next, then, finally. Using our trip to Tower Bridge as inspiration, we researched nouns (cog and pivot) and verbs (rotate and wind) using iPads and dictionaries and then wrote a table of bridge vocabulary complete with words and pictures.

<u>Maths</u>

This week we have finished learning about 'position and direction'. We used the tally charts we made during our visit to Tower Bridge to make a pictogram and a block diagram (bar chart). For the next two weeks, Year 2 will be preparing for Year 3 by revising our method for the 4 operations and starting to learn the formal column method used for addition and subtraction in Year 3.
