<u>English</u>

This week, in preparation for our trip to Tower Bridge, we learnt some harder to read and spell words – such as after and past. We then learnt different 'j' graphemes: -dge, 'ge and j- and used a dictionary to look up any that we didn't know the meaning of. Following our visit to Tower Bridge, before we start reading 'Rosie Revere Engineer' we are going to have a competition to build a bridge from Lego – just like they did in the 1870s to find the best design for London's new bridge!

Maths

This week we have started our final unit of White Rose Maths - position and direction. We are learning about the language of position and direction - forwards, backwards, left and right and also how to describe a turn - clockwise or anticlockwise.

Next Year

In Year 3, the children will have a daily reading slot in which they will have an opportunity to write in their own reading record so these will need to be in school every day.

In preparation for this, and as the children enter key stage 2, I am encouraging them to take ownership of this and check that they have their reading record (and a book - of their choosing if they are an independent reader) in their bag daily.
