English

This week in English we have continued to work on our book, *Black Dog* by Levi Pinfold. This week's learning was grammar-focused. The children looked at sentence types: statement, question, exclamation and command, focusing on using the correct punctuation to form sentences. We also recapped on how to use apostrophes. We looked at how apostrophes are used for both contractions and for possession.

Maths

This week we have continued to focus on shape. We have looked at: identifying 2D shapes, identifying 3D shapes and sorting and ordering them in accordance to the number of vertices, edges and faces they have. Next week we will be moving onto statistics: analysing pictograms, bar graphs and line graphs.
