Our Learning This Week

English

In English, the children completed their exploration of 'Weslandia' by writing a travel brochure. We focussed on some the keys areas in this unique civilisation and wrote paragraphs for each one including an introduction and conclusion. The children did an initial first draft before writing it up in the presentation style of a pamphlet. The children have worked well on this text and have produced creative and innovative ideas in response to this thought-provoking story. Next week, we will be focusing on grammar revising what the children have learnt during the course of the year.

Maths

This week, the children completed their topic on Position and Direction and then moved on to revise fractions. The children were reminded of what unit and non-unit fractions are and how to recognise, find and write fractions of a discrete set of objects. Next week we will continue with our work on fractions and how these can be converted into decimals.

P.E

This half term the children have been learning to play Rounders. We have focussed on how to throw under and over arm, how to bat and field as well as starting to learn the rules of how to play the game. The children have been really enjoying these sessions and next week we will finish by playing a whole class match.
