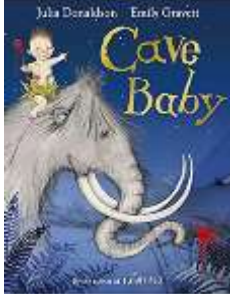




Year 1 Homework Letter - Friday 22nd September
