## English, Maths and Reading.

Last week was assessment week and the children were assessed in Reading, Writing and Maths. The purpose of this is to enable us to identify any gaps in your child's previous learning from Year 2. Knowing this allows us to address these gaps promptly so your child can make the best possible start to Year 3. I am very proud of how hard the children have worked since coming back and they have tackled each 'special challenge' with great enthusiasm and dedication. Year 3 is a step up in terms of expectations of behaviour as we get the children ready for their journey through Key Stage 2.

#### Reading

This year, we are encouraging the children to grow in independence and start taking responsibility for their own learning. As part of this, the children are now being asked to write in their own reading logs which are overseen by an adult. Please encourage your child to read every night as this is a fundamental skill in supporting them with using higher level language, correct grammar and punctuation. Please do however continue to sit and listen to them read and record a comment if you can. This is also a great opportunity for you to ask question about the book and challenge their understanding of what they have just read.

### Harvest Service at Christ Church

The service will take place at 9.30am on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> October and we warmly invite parents to worship with us. Every year during Harvest we collect specific food items. #### Maths

Please use Purple Mash and Timetables Rockstars to practise the timetables. The programme works using an algorithm to test your child to their ability. Once they are confident with the 2, 5 and 10 x then move onto 3, 4 and 8 x. Use songs on Purple Mash and YouTube to help learn them alongside using TTRS. The passwords for this can be found in the front of the homework book. I will be checking in to see if children are logging in, which they should become proficient with this and know their login details. A quick practise a day will make all the difference in helping them to learn the tímes tables.
