# Our Learning This Week English

In English this week, we have started reading 'Swift's Gulliver' retold by Martin Jenkins. The children have written a description of Gulliver using facts and inference from the text. We have written sentences using fronted adverbials to express the time, place and manner in which events have occurred for him. The children have also used different sentence types (command, statement, exclamation and question) to design a poster all about Gulliver.

### <u>Maths</u>

This week in Maths, we have been learning how to represent numbers to 1,000 including those that have no tens or no ones, to reinforce the idea of using zero as a placeholder. We have been partitioning numbers up to 1,000 writing the numbers in expanded form identifying the number of hundreds, tens and ones in a 3-digit number. The children have revisited using a number line to 1,000, labelling, identify and finding missing values on blank or partially completed ones. The children also looked at the composition of multiples of 1,000 by exploring how many hundreds they are made of. The children have applied themselves fully to this work and are all making super progress.

#### Homework

This week's English activities are to learn the spellings for Week 1 set on Purple Mash. For Maths the children must practise their times tables on Times Tables Rock Stars. All log in details have been stuck into the children's reading logs and the programs explained to them in class.

#### Love Project

We are very much looking forward to being able to hold our Harvest Service at Christ Church once again. The service will take place at 9.30 on Thursday 5th October and we warmly invite parents to worship with us. Every year during Harvest we collect specific food items.
