



<u>Year 4 Homework Letter - Friday 22nd September 2023</u>

Our Learning This Week

English

In English this week, the main focus of our learning has been on grammar. They have been developing their skills in writing compound and complex sentences using coordinating and subordinate conjunctions. The children have also learnt what a modal verb is and how to use them. I have been most impressed by the children's grasp of these different grammatical features and the fantastic progress they are all making. **Maths**

This week in Maths, the children explored flexible partitioning of numbers up to 10,000, understanding that the whole number can be split into parts in many different ways. We also looked at finding 1, 10, 100 and 1,000 more or less than a number with up to four digits. Building on previous learning of number lines to 1,000, this week the children moved on to look at number lines to 10,000. We ended our week focusing on comparing numbers up to 10,000 using language such as greater/smaller than, less/more than. The children then progressed to using the inequality symbols, <, > and =, which they have encountered in previous years.

Homework

This week's English activity is to learn the spellings for Week 2 on Purple Mash. For Maths the children must practise their times table on Times Tables Rock Stars. The children's login details have been stuck into the front cover of their reading logs. Please encourage your child to read every evening and to make a note of what they have read in their logs.
