# Our Learning This Week English

In English this week, we have started reading 'The Lost Happy Endings' by Carol Ann Duffy. The children have begun to predict what might happen from details stated and implied as well as writing stanzas using collective and abstract nouns in order to create an image. We have also explored mood in a piece of writing, where the children have been altering the mood in their writing through changing the vocabulary used.

### **Maths**

This week in Maths, the children have learnt to understand the value of each digit in numbers up to 10,000, 100,000 and 1,000,000. Specifically, we have introduced the ten thousands column and the hundred thousands column, ensuring they understand the value of digits in these columns. The children have also learnt how to partition numbers up to 100,000 identifying the number of ten thousands, thousands, hundreds, tens and ones. The children have also become proficient in adding and subtracting numbers up to 100,000 relating this to the place value charts. The children have fully applied themselves this week and are making wonderful progress.
