




# <u> Year 1 Homework Letter - Fríday 13th October</u>



#### Maths

This week we have started a new unit on 'Addition and subtraction'. The children have explored parts and wholes, and were introduced to the part-whole model. This is sometimes referred to as a "cherry model". The main teaching point for the children to see was that a whole group of objects can be composed of two or more parts and that they can represent this using a part-whole model. The group can be split in a variety of different ways.
