

# <u>Year 3 Homework Letter</u> 29<sup>th</sup> September 2023



## <u>English</u>

This week we have been retelling the 'Heart and the Bottle' story. The children have been given a number of sentences from the story which they have used to 'up-level' which means improving and making it more interesting! So we looked at adding a:

- fronted adverbial a word which describes how or when you did something
- adjectives to describe
- conjunctions words like but, so and or to extend the sentence to make it more interesting!

In guided reading, we have read a fascinating book called 'Lost Species' which we have really enjoyed. Ask the children to tell you about some of the interesting creatures we learnt about from the Spinosaurus to the Dodo! For the rest of the half term we will be working on reading comprehension skills.

#### <u>Maths</u>

This week in Maths we have continued to look at place value. We have learnt to:

- -place numbers on a number line from 10 up to 1,000
- to estimate numbers on a number line from 10 to 1,000

This is a big jump up! We ended our week with a practical lesson where the children worked in groups using string for a number line and writing numbers on whiteboard to physically place on the line.
