Our Learning This Week English

In English this week, the children have continued their exploration of 'Gulliver's Travels'. We have focussed some of learning on our understanding of different noun types including common and proper nouns.



<u> Maths</u>

This week in Maths, the children have started their new unit on Addition and Subtraction. In Year 3, they explored adding and subtracting 1s, 10s and 100s to/from any 3-digit number, including using a mental strategy when crossing a multiple of 10 or 100. We spent some time re-capping on this learning and extending their understanding to dealing with 4-digit numbers and adding and subtracting multiples of 1,000. The focus was on mental rather than written strategies, which are covered later in the block.
