<u>Our Learníng Thís Week</u> <u>Englísh</u>

In English this week, we have learnt how to plan the structure and content of a narrative, drawing upon ideas of authors and peers. Basing their writing on the text, 'The Lost Happy Endings' the children have used adverbials to aid cohesion and have written excellent narratives. Everyone has also developed their formal writing and knowledge of the subjunctive form. Nearing the end of the week the children have consolidated their knowledge of metaphors and have begun to explore the use of extended metaphors in writing. <u>Maths</u>

This week in maths, the children have learnt how to compare and order numbers to 100,000 and 1,000,000. Everyone has also learnt how to round numbers to the nearest 10, 100 or 1,000 as well has consolidating their knowledge on number lines. Specifically, the children have been learning what the value of each interval is on a number line as well as estimating where numbers would be. The children have fully applied themselves this week and are making amazing progress.
