


Year 6 Homework letter - Friday 06.10.2023



English: This week we continued to look at our reading and comprehension based on the book 'War Horse'. Together, we read chapters two and three in class. The children individually answered questions based on the text focusing on their inference skills to obtain answers that are not necessarily evident within the text. This week in English, we continued our book 'Romeo and Juliet'. Within our lessons we have focused on use of adverbial phrases to add detail to our writing. Later in the week we looked at dialogue between characters and how actions can help portray how a character is feeling.

Maths: This week in Maths we continued our recapping of the column method of addition and subtraction. We focused first on reminding ourselves the basic layout and place value. Later on in the week we moved on to prime numbers, squared numbers and cubed numbers. We then finished the week of by reminding ourselves how to correctly use the formal method of multiplication when multiplying a four-digit number by a two-digit number:
