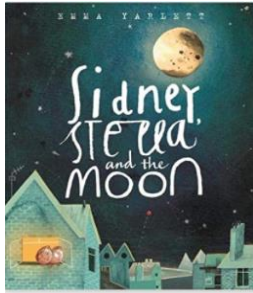




Year 1 Homework Letter - Friday 3rd November 2023

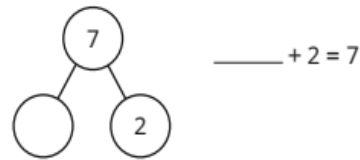
Max has these sweets.

Complete the part-whole model and the number sentence.

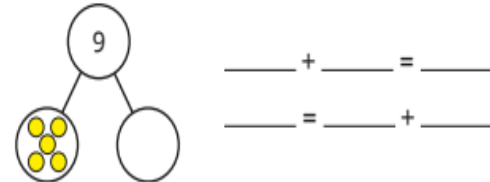


There are 7 cars in total.
