



## Year 2 Homework letter - Friday 10th November 2023

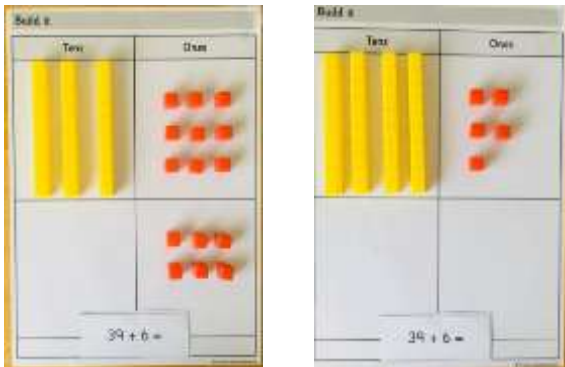
Please continue to practise the Nativity lines with your child as often as possible.
