Phonics

This week we have continued to revise all the Phase 3 phonemes and 'Harder to Read and Spell' words we have learnt so far this term.

Next week we will be having a 'Christmas' themed week in the EYFS classroom. The school shop will be turned into a 'Christmas' shop and we will also be having a special 'Elf' wrapping station where children can practise wrapping up boxes and writing gift labels.
