The Expressive Arts Concert was a triumph with children playing and singing so beautifully. Thank you to the parents, carers, friends and family for supporting. We are very grateful to you all for helping the children raise £128.10. This money will be used specifically for our Expressive Arts Curriculum. We also enjoyed a really special Christmas Service at Christ Church. The choir sang beautifully, Faith Team led prayers and Reception and KS1 sang a song from their recent Nativity 'Lights Camel Action' which was a real treat. I am always so moved at the end of term by how well our children do and was so proud of the whole school on that day.

Christmas lunch went really well too! Thank you to our PTFA who organised crackers for the tables and the Christmas Fayre the following day.

La Posadda

In the week leading up to Christmas the children at Nutfield Church School re-enacted their own La Posada celebration. La Posada, which in Spanish means "The Inn" is a religious festival celebrated in Mexico between 16 and 24 December. La Posada commemorates the journey that Joseph and Mary made from Nazareth to Bethlehem in search of safe refuge, where Mary could give birth to the baby Jesus. A small basket containing two knitted figurines of Mary and Joseph began in Reception class and made the 'journey' from classroom to classroom each day. Children learnt from La Posada that by welcoming the poor and the needy, they are welcoming Jesus into their hearts (See Matthew 25:40). La Posada is a beautiful way to focus the celebrations of Christmas on the incarnation of Christ, to learn hospitality and to become mindful of those who are seeking shelter. This is particularly poignant this term, as we have been raising money for 'Open Hands Reigate' through our Autumn term 'Love Project'.

Love Works - Tin a Week

Our 'Love Project' this term focuses on supporting families who are in need. We recognise that times can be tough for families and the children have once again nominated Love Works as their Spring Term charity. On Wednesday last Wednesday, we were visited by Graham Humphries from Love Works. One function that is particularly useful to many people is their food bank. The idea this term is that we ask each family to bring a tin or packet of food each week to school. Each class' collection will then be taken to the food bank.

Equality Ambassadors

The Equality Ambassadors have made a strong start to the year by continuing to analyse their research around authors in our school library. They will be sharing the information they found out and their next steps in our meeting

soon. They have been awarded Equality Ambassadors' badges in recognition of their excellent service to our Welcome project. Our hope is that through their work our children will be directly involved in making sure our school is welcoming for everyone. Their maturity as a group is impressive. Thank you to Year 6, Mr Bowen, Mrs Ross and our Equality Ambassador Governors for your support in this.
