<u>English</u>

How odd! This was the 'hook' for our new text which we will be enjoying over the next three weeks - 'The Bear Under the Stairs' by Helen Cooper.

A lso we looked at identifying homophones (words which sound the same but have different spellings and meanings) and used the word from the title—'Bear'—to start us off eg. This week in Maths our focus has been multiplication and division. We have learnt about equal groups in preparation for learning how to multiply and divide. We are also practising times tables every afternoon this week we focused on the 2 times table.
