This week, Year 3 have been planning and writing *their own version of 'Leon and the Place Between'* by Angela McAllister. This week we have:


- Planned a story in pairs and used a story-board to condense the story into 6 key events

Maths:

This week, we have moved on to formal multiplication methods.

Multiplying a 2 digit number by a 1 digit number—no exchange

Each tray has 24 rolls.
How many rolls are there in total?



$2 \times 20 = 40$
 $2 \times 4 = 8$

$\begin{array}{r} 2 \text{ tens multiplied by } 2 \text{ is equal to } 40 \\ 4 \text{ ones multiplied by } 2 \text{ is equal to } 8 \\ \hline 24 \text{ multiplied by } 2 \text{ is equal to } 48 \end{array}$

There are 48 rolls in total.

Multiplying a 2 digit number by a 1 digit number—with exchange

$26 \times 3 = 78$

2 tens \times 3 = 6 tens
6 ones \times 3 = 18 ones
 $26 \times 3 = 60 + 18 = 78$
