## <u>Our Learníng Thís Week</u> <u>Englísh</u>

In English this week, the children have started our new text, 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe' by C.S Lewis. We have learnt how to write relative clauses in relation to key aspects of the story so far. The children did so well at this we have written them up to use for our English display board. We also thought about how the author uses the five senses (sight, sound, taste, touch, and smell) to engage the reader. The children were able to find evidence from the text to show how C.S Lewis had achieved this. If you have time over the next week if would be useful for the children to have their own copies - any of the publications will be fine to use.

# <u>Homework</u>

The English activities are to learn Week 2 spellings and to read for at least 15 minutes each evening. For Maths the children must practise all of their times tables on Times Tables Rock Stars.

#### <u>Maths</u>

The children have been continuing to learn about multiplication and division this week. They have learnt how to use a variety of informal written methods to multiply a 2digit number by a 1-digit number by using place value charts to recognise multiples of a number and make the link to repeated addition. We then progressed on to multiplying a 3-ditigt number by a 1-digit number using the formal column method. We ended the week by learning how to divide by 10 and 100. The children used place value charts to see the link between dividing by 10 or by 100 and the position of the digits of a number before and after the calculation.

# <u>Wellbeing</u>

In P.E this half term the children will be learning how to play hockey. For our PSHE lessons we are exploring the topic of 'Caring and Responsibility' and will be learning about the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child. The children will get the opportunity to participate in another 'Wellbeing Wednesday' on the 31<sup>st</sup> January, enjoying a whole morning of sport. They will need their full P.E kit for this session.
