



<u> Year 4 Homework Letter - Fríday 26th January 2024</u>

<u>Our Learning This Week</u> <u>English</u>

In English this week, we have continued exploring our current text, 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe' by C.S Lewis. The children have used expanded noun phrases to express an emotional response to the character of Aslan and to describe their own alternative version to this lead character. We considered certain scenes from the story and explored how the *authorial technique of using humour can* give a reader 'light relief' from a tense moment. The children went on to infer and *deduce what might have been said between* Mr Beaver and Father Christmas in a conversation not included by the author devising, performing and writing their own scripted scenes.

<u>Maths</u>

This week, we have started our new unit on 'Length and Perimeter'. In previous years, children measured lengths using metres (m) and centimetres (cm). They have now been introduced to kilometres and the abbreviation 'km'. The children used the fact that 1 km is equal to 1,000 m to derive related facts using numbers up to 10,000. *The children explored perimeter focussing* on calculating the perimeter of rectangles using the side lengths, rather than counting the squares. This work was developed *further by calculating the perimeter of* rectilinear shapes, where all sides meet at right angles. The children were taught that when calculating perimeter they should mark the sides they have already counted to avoid duplication or omission.

<u>Arts</u>

This half term, the children are learning about the life and work of Frida Kahlo. They have drawn self-portraits using pencil and then moved on to paint a second selfportrait using watercolour paint.
