English: This week the children started their new English book 'Beowulf by Michael $\mathcal{M}$ Morpurgo. We began the week by familiarising ourselves with A nglo-Sax on and Viking language. These are refer red to as K ennings.
A kenning is a figure of speech, a roundabout, two-w ord phrase used in the place of a
 one-w ord noun.
A fter reading the introduction to the Beowulf story and hearing the perils that would befall K ing H rothgar and his kingdom, we used subjunctive mood to write a persuasive letter to help best prepare his kingdom for what ter rors lie ahead. The subjunctive mood is a verb form used to refer to a hypothetical scenario or to express a wish, suggestion, or command (e.g. 'I suggest you be quiet').

## M aths:

Over the next two weeks Year 6 will be focusing on ratio. In $M$ athematics, a ratio shows how many times one number contains another. F or example, if there are eight or anges and six lemons in a bowl of fruit, then the ratio of oranges to lemons is eight to six (that is, 8:6). We then looked at simplifying ratios. So the ratios of oranges to lemons is 8:6 and that can be simplified to 4:3. To end the week we looked at turning ratios into fractions. So with the ratio 8:6 the 8 represents 8/ 14 and the 6 represents 6/ 14.
