This week we have learnt the phonemes: ure, er, ow There are no new 'Harder to Read and Spell words' this week.

Our Learning this week

We have been exploring rockets and space travel. In our literacy lesson we have enjoyed reading the book 'Man on the Moon - a day in the life of Bob' by Simon Batram. We tried to remember three things that Bob did during his day and created a storyboard which included a picture and a sentence.

In our enhanced provision the children have been busy making alien spaceships in the art area and creating their own 3D aliens using green playdoh and craft materials to sit in their spaceships.

This week, we set up a 'I wonder...' station for the children to investigate. This station contained globes, pictures of the solar system, torches and lots of interesting books on Space for the children to explore. We left out chalk boards for children to write any 'I wonder' questions they had about space too.

In EAD (Expressive Arts and Design) the children have been learning about marbelling. With adult guidance the children created their own planets using the marbelling technique they had been taught. These look fantastic and will be displayed in our annual art exhibition at the end of the year.

In R.E. this week we have been thinking about all the creatures Christians believe God created. The children all selected one animal they thought was the most important and as a class we considered whether the tiny woodlouse or the humble earth worm were just as important as the majestic lion. All the children agreed that all animals were just as important as each other. Outside we had set up a woodland habitat with worms and woodlice. The children used magnisfying glasses, magnifying pots, sampling equipment and microscopes to investigate these minibeasts in detail.
