



<u>Year 4 Homework Letter - Friday 23rd February 2024</u>

Our Learning This Week English

In English this week, we have finished reading and studying the text of 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe' by completing and writing up their own version of the story. After much preparation, including writing a story mountain and then writing a draft of each paragraph the children wrote their story up in neat using cursive script. Their stories were an adaptation of the original and had to include the use of paragraphs, correct punctuation, fronted adverbials, expanded noun phrases and conjunctions. The children have worked very hard and I am looking forward to reading and marking them.

<u>Maths</u>

This week the children have started their new topic learning about fractions. We began this block by understanding the whole and recapping the part-whole relationship of fractions. The children then built on their knowledge of the whole to *explore fractions greater than 1. We then* further developed the children's understanding of mixed numbers and explored partitioning mixed numbers in different ways - a skill that will be vital for later steps in this unit of study. We learnt how mixed numbers are represented on a number line and how to convert mixed numbers into improper fractions and improper fractions to mixed numbers.

Homework

The English activities are to learn Week 1 spellings and to read for at least 15 minutes each evening. For Maths, the children must continue to practise all of their times tables on 'Times Tables Rock Stars'.
