



<u>Year 5 Homework Letter - Friday 2nd February 2024</u>

<u>English</u>

In English this week we have been proposing changes to vocabulary, grammar and punctuation to enhance effects and clarify meaning based on the book Curiosity: The Story of a Mars Rover. The children also learnt to write a newspaper report based on Curiosity landing on Mars. In their newspaper reports, the children included the headline, the summary and the main body. The children also learnt how to use presentational devices to help guide the reader such as headings and titles.

Maths

In Maths, we continued with fractions. The children learnt how to find a fraction of an amount and also the whole. To find the fraction of an amount, you divide the whole by the denominator. To find the whole you have to multiply the denominator by the part. Here are some examples:

<u>Fraction of the</u> amount

<u>Finding the whole</u>

$$\frac{1}{4}$$
 of 48 = 12

$$\frac{1}{4}$$
 of $32 = 8$

The children also learnt to use fractions as operators, such as multiplying fractions by an integer.

Homework

Spelling: The children should complete the 10 spellings for week 5 set on Purple Mash. Maths: Everyone must practise their times tables on Times Tables Rock Stars. Reading: The children must also read for at least 15 minutes per day and comment in their reading log.
