## Our Learning this week

We have continued to learn about Space, focusing particularly on the Moon. In our literacy lessons we have been reading 'Whatever Next' by Jill Murphy. In this story we joined Baby Bear on his adventure to the Moon. Baby Bear manages to find a rocket, make friends with an owl and have a picnic on the Moon whilst still managing to make it back home before bathtime! In response to the book, the children have been writing about Baby Bear's thoughts when he first landed on the Moon.

In our 'Understanding the World' lesson we have continued to learn about astronauts. We thought about what an astronaut would need to travel into Space and what they might do when they arrive. We learnt that astronauts are scientists who want to find out more about the places that they visit in Space.

In the art room we have been busy making paintings of the Moon. We used white paint mixed with flour so our pictures resembled the texture of the moon. We then wrote sentences to describe the appearance and size of the Moon.

We thought about why we can only sometimes see part of the Moon in the sky and used playdoh to recreate the different phases of the Moon. We also looked at different star constellations and used black paper, white crayons and gold stars to copy some of the constellations we might see in the sky.

In Maths we have been learning all about making pairs, doubling and odd and even numbers. The children enjoyed playing with our Noah's Ark boat and finding doubles of animals to go into the ark. Children also enjoyed playing with the dice to see if they could throw a 'double number.'

## Homework

Please continue to read daily with your child and write a comment in your child's yellow reading log. We have also set an E-Book on Oxford Owl for you to read with your child.
