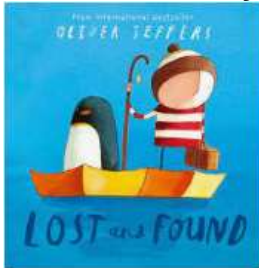




## Year 1 Homework Letter - Friday 22nd March 2024

### Maths

During our Maths lessons this week we have focused on mass and volume. We began by holding objects to compare them, using the language of "heavier" or "lighter". We then used balance scales to check our comparisons and used a variety of non-standard units, such as cubes or bricks, to measure the mass of an object:

● If you add one more cube, what will happen?

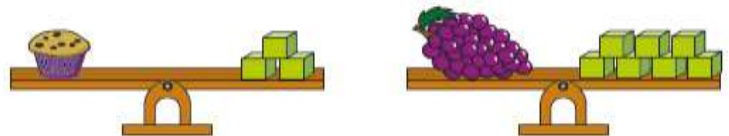
If you take away one cube, what will happen?
