English

This week, Year 3 have continued reading 'Black Dog'. This week we have:

- identified and used contractions
- Written a conversation focusing on the use of contractions and synonyms (similar words) for said
- Written noun phrases, the mean, hairy dog
- Used powerful verbs like scurried and scuttled to describe the dog's movement

Maths

This week, we are still learning about Measure and Perimeter. This week we have:

- Looked at the relationship between mm, cm and m eg there are 10 mm in 1cm
- Equivalent cm and m
- Equivalent mm and cm
- Comparing length for example which is bigger 5cm or 6 mm
- A practical lesson to help consolidate this week's learning

If you have time, take the opportunity to get the tape measure or ruler out and get measuring!

Reading: Please try to read every evening with your child. Do continue to ask them questions about what they have read to check their understanding. Currently we are doing a weekly group read so each child gets to read a book once a week in a group with an adult where good expression and tonation is encouraged, as well as helping the children to work on their fluency.

Multiplication: Please use Times Tables Rock Stars to help improve your child's understanding and knowledge of the times tables. It is a fun and interactive way to improve their number fluency. So please encourage your child to do this every weekend as part of their homework. By now they should know the 2, 5 and 10 times tables very well by now. We are now looking at those who have earned the most coins and got the most answers right for a weekly certificate.

Spellings: Use the sheet provided to complete this week's spellings. An optional quiz will also be set on Purple Mash to complete. Please note sheets do not need to be returned. Some children will receive an additional set of spellings, and these should be the set they are focusing on. But by all means have a go at the other set too!
