The children have really enjoyed swimming this week. They have given it 100% and are all making progress.

<u>English</u>

This week, for Book Week, we are reading a whole school text, Journey. This is a wordless text. This week we have:

- Thought about the title and answered questions to spark imagination linking to the ideas in the story
- We used abstract nouns to write a short description of the girl as she enters the magical world
- Used drama to think about the characters in the story and what they were thinking and saying and used this to write a conversation concentrating on the rules for speech.

Maths

This week, we have continued learning about Measure and Perimeter. This week we have been:

- Adding lengths
- Subtracting lengths
- What is perimeter?
- Calculating perimeter
- Measuring perimeter

It is essential that the children know that 10mm = 1cm and 100cm = 1m.

Easter Gardens

St Peter's and St Paul's Church are inviting the children to create an Easter Garden at home, an Easter Garden is the recreation of Christ's tomb. It has three essential features: a mound with at least one cross to represent Calvary; a stone or stone structure to suggest the empty tomb; and lots of live greenery and flowers. <u>Homework</u>

Reading: Please try to read every evening with your child. Do continue to ask them questions about what they have read to check their understanding. Currently we are doing a weekly group read so each child gets to read a book once a week in a group with an adult where good expression and tonation is encouraged, as well as helping the children to work on their fluency.

Multiplication: Please use Times Tables Rock Stars to help improve your child's understanding and knowledge of the times tables. It is a fun and interactive way to improve their number fluency. So please encourage your child to do this every weekend as part of their homework. By now they should know the 2, 5 and 10 times tables very well. We are now looking at those who have earned the most coins and got the most answers right for a weekly certificate!
