### Our Learning This Week

#### English

In English this week, the children have been assessed on their reading and comprehension, spelling grammar and punctuation and writing. They all worked hard in their preparations for the assessments and tried their best in each one.

#### Maths

In Maths this week, the children have been assessed on Arithmetic and Reasoning. As with the English papers, the children spent time revising prior to doing the assessments to give them the best opportunity to feel prepared.

#### Gatton Park
